## Emergencies



Our physicians are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Any time you have a life-threatening emergency, call 911. If, however, our office is closed and you need to speak with one of our physicians, simply call in to the office for instruction. Our answering service will relay your phone number to the doctor who will call you back promptly. If you do not receive a phone call back within 20 minutes, call the service back directly. Have a pen and paper ready for any information the doctor may give you.

# Appointments

Our patients are seen by appointment. Appointments can be scheduled by calling the office during regular business hours. We encourage you to come prepared with a list of questions and concerns that you would like answered when you come for your visit with the doctor. We ask that you arrive 10 minutes prior to your appointment time; doing so allows us to update your child's information and complete the check-in process.

If you are unable to keep your appointment, please contact the office far enough in advance so that we can use that time for other patients. We ask that you give 2 hours notice when cancelling a sick visit and that you give 24 hours notice for a Well Visit / Physical cancellation. While we understand that emergencies do arise, we reserve the right to charge for missed appointments when an appointment is not kept or inadequate notice is given.

# Prescriptions / Referrals

Please call during regular business hours for prescription refills and insurance referrals. Whenever possible, allow 24 – 48 hours notice when calling for medication refills and 7 – 14 days when requesting a referral.

Always bring your insurance card and co-pay with you to every visit. We accept cash, checks, Visa, Mastercard, and Discover.
